### **Position: Farmer/Gardener**

#### **About The Organization:**

#### **Position Summary:**

The Farmer/Gardener is part of the Building and Grounds team. The primary duty is to operate one greenhouse and one or two garden beds over a 15 week season. The aim is to produce organic produce to supplement dining service meals. The position reports to the B&G Manager.

The contract is from early/mid June - mid September. Priority is given to candidates who will be available for that entire window.

#### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Reclaim an unused greenhouse and prepare it for use.
- Prepare one or two organic garden beds for use.
- Plan, plant, tend, and harvest fast-growing vegetables such as lettuce, greens, spinach, radishes, beans, peas.
- Maintain flower gardens around Lloyd Lodge.
- Assist with lawn maintenance.
- Incorporate volunteer help as available.
- Perform basic maintenance, landscaping, and special projects as assigned
- Assist with opening and shutting down all WFC gardens.
- Additional duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

- General familiarity with tools and equipment related to landscaping and gardening.
- Landscaping and gardening experience is preferred
- Valid driver's license with ability to operate WFC vehicles
- Alignment with WFC's mission and vision and a desire to work on a team striving for a more just world
- Strong communication and collaboration skills
- Time management skills and a desire for efficiency & problem-solving
- Ability to receive and provide constructive feedback
- Hospitality mindset, comfortable involving volunteers in the work
- Ability to move across campus, indoors and outdoors, multiple times per day including frequent stair use and extended periods of walking, standing, and sitting
- Lift and carry up to 50 pounds
- Up to date with current COVID-19 vaccine recommendations
- Promote a customer-service & team attitude towards guests, volunteers, and staff
